Tests have shown that thousands of <u>earthquakes</u> happen every year. They remain <u>unnoticed</u> since they are very weak. However recently the number of earthquakes has <u>increased</u> and in some parts the <u>level</u> of the ground has risen. In the last 2.1 million years there have been three <u>super</u> eruptions. Most experts believe there is no <u>immediate</u> danger of another giant <u>explosion</u>, but it's impossible to be sure.
